## LOOMS

### SAORI 60 Series

SAORI 60 (all wood frame):	\$1588
SAORI 60A-2 (all wood frame; wheelchair accessible; height-adjustable):	\$1738
SAORI 60 w/4harnesses:	\$2051
SAORI SX 60 (foldable, highly portable, wood & metal frame):	\$1423

SAORI SX60-H (SX60 with longer metal legs – for taller people):	\$1519

Each new SAORI 60 Series loom includes: 1 complete harness set to match the loom (2 or 4 harnesses); 1 reed; 1 shuttle; 1 denting hook; 1 heddle hook; 2 tying rods; 1 pkg. 15 bobbins *without* metal ends (rims/flanges). Also, the looms come with 1 pre-rolled and threaded 150-thread, **6-meter** black cotton warp rolled on a **re-usable** cardboard rolling tube.

**SAORI PICCOLO Series:** Designed for children as well as for adult weavers of average size or smaller, this loom has a light-weight metal frame that is extendable, foldable, & highly portable. There are 3 models, which vary as to whether or not they include: a shelf for convenient placement of accessories (scissors, bobbins, etc.); a clamp to hold the folded loom closed; an attached bobbin winder.

Piccolo A (no shelf, no clamp, no winder)	\$828
Piccolo B (shelf & clamp, but no winder)	\$882
Piccolo C (shelf, clamp, & winder)	\$974

Each new Piccolo loom includes: 1 two-harness set; 1 reed; 1 pre-rolled and threaded 150-thread, 6-meter black cotton warp with re-usable cardboard rolling tube, and 1 tying rod with a clip that makes tying the warp to the rod with knots unnecessary. No other accessories are included; therefore, when ordering your Piccolo loom, we suggest you consult us regarding what accessories you will need to fit your plans.

**Ordering your Loom:** We place one or two multi-loom orders to Japan each year, usually in spring and fall: order dates are posted at [Hhttp://saoriworcester.com](http://saoriworcester.com)H at least 6 weeks in advance. A deposit of \$250 will reserve the loom of your choice in our next order. **Piccolo Exception:** We can special-order one or more **Piccolos** for you at any time; however, higher shipping costs may apply to such orders. In all cases, full payment for any loom is expected within 30 days of its arrival at our studio, unless otherwise arranged.

**ACCESSORIES****“Inside Set” Accessories**

A key advantage of the SAORI loom is that one can remove an entire work-in-progress (harnesses, reed, warp rolled on tube, and tying rod) from the loom and replace it with a different “inside set”, composed of these 4 items. Thus, one can use a single loom for multiple works-in-progress by using multiple “inside sets.”

Harness set (2 harnesses): For SAORI 60 Series loom \$168 / For Piccolo Series Loom \$84

Reed (available in a variety of densities): For SAORI 60 Series loom \$91 / For Piccolo Series loom \$68

Tying Rod with Clip<sup>1</sup>: For SAORI 60 Series loom \$16 / For Piccolo Series loom \$15

Tying Rod w/o Clip for all looms: \$7

Cardboard Warp-rolling Tube for SAORI 60 Series or Piccolo Series (specify Series)<sup>2</sup>: \$7

Tube with cloth apron attached for SAORI 60 Series or Piccolo Series (specify Series)<sup>2</sup>: \$15

Pre-Rolled **30-meter** black cotton *or* wool warp for SAORI 60 or Piccolo Series (specify Series)<sup>2,3</sup>:

100 threads            \$59

150 threads            \$74

200 threads            \$80

<sup>1</sup>Clips warp threads to rod, eliminating need for hand-tying

<sup>2</sup>Piccolo tube is shorter than 60 Series tube, but pre-rolled warp on either tube has same number of threads.

<sup>3</sup>Other thread-numbers & meter-lengths available by special order; other colors *sometimes* on offer from factory
